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## **MISSION STATEMENT**

Tibetan Homes Foundation is an integrated charitable institution established to impart to the children under its fold holistic education that combines the fundamentals of the unique Tibetan culture, language and identity and the modern systems of learning ultimately making the children compassionate, self-reliant and responsible members of the Tibetan society and the humanity at large.

### **1. (A) Accessibility Criteria**

The Scholarship is open to all Tibetan Homes Foundation Wards (THFW) on the basis of the eligibility criteria specified in this THF Scholarship Guidelines and any subsequent amendments made by THF Scholarship Policy Committee (SPC) from time to time. THFW applying for scholarship must submit an attested copy their updated Green Book and valid Registration Certificate for Tibetans (RC).

The scholarships shall be given only for full time regular courses in a college/university/training institute recognized by the Central or State Government of India or Department of Education (DOE), Central Tibetan Administration (CTA) or one approved by THF, SPC. No scholarship will be given for part time courses. A scholarship beneficiary is not permitted to change the course of study/program without obtaining prior approval from the Chairman, THF, SPC.

### **(B) Cardinal Condition**

- (i) All scholarship holders are required to sign the MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (form A) as an undertaking that he/she will follow all the rules and regulations mentioned in this THF Scholarship Guidelines before joining any Academic/Vocational institutions.
- (ii) On completion of one's course of study/program, COURSE COMPLETION REPORT (form C) must be filled and submit the same to the Education Officer/ Head of the Scholarship Section for possible placement within THF and to remove his/her name from the higher studies scholarship enrolment.
- (iii) THFW must inform of his/her current status and location so that the THF-Sponsorship Section can maintain contact with all the THFW as a member of THF Alumni.

### **(C) Value of scholarship**

- (i) The Value of the scholarship for various courses of study shall be as specified in the Details of Basic Scholarship Amount and

Disbursement of Scholarships. (Table No. II and III on pages 14 & 15).

- (ii) For courses/programs/trainings other than the ones specified in this booklet, THF SPC shall determine and fix the value of the scholarship.

**(D) Definition of the Terminologies used in this booklet.**

- (i) **CTA:-** Central Tibetan Administration, Dharamsala.  
(ii) **DOE:-** Department of Education, CTA.  
(iii) **THF:-** Tibetan Homes Foundation, Mussoorie.  
(iv) **THFW:-** Wards of Tibetan Homes Foundation.  
(v) **SPC:-** Scholarship Policy Committee, THF.  
(vi) **SS:-** Scholarship Section, THF.  
(vii) **THS:-** Tibetan Homes School, Mussoorie.  
(viii) **BPE:-** Bonus Point for Excellence.

**2. Awarding of Scholarship:**

The matters pertaining to awarding THF scholarship shall be decided by the THF, SPC while the day to day dispensation work shall be carried out by the SS.

**(A) THF SCHOLARSHIP POLICY COMMITTEE (SPC)**

(The Asst. Secretary shall chair the meeting in the absence of the General Secretary)

**Responsibilities**

- i. Formulate scholarship policies and guidelines for students for higher studies or trainings after school graduation.
- ii. Make periodic appraisals and evaluate the THF Higher Studies and Training policies to make them relevant to the times and needs of the Tibetan community.
- iii. Award special scholarship in order to encourage wards to opt specialization courses.
- iv. Provide counseling to THFW shortly after the declaration of AISSCE(XII) results to enable them to take courses/trainings

- appropriate to one's scholastic aptitude and interest.
- v. Meet once a year to review and appraise the THF scholarship program and make amendments accordingly.
  - vi. In the event of an exigent situation that warrants quick action, Chairman of the SPC can make a decision to address the situation.

### **(B) SCHOLARSHIP SECTION (SS)**

The THF Scholarship Section shall have a section head who shall carry out the day to day activities according to the THF Scholarship Guidelines. The section head shall function as the member secretary of the SPC.

#### **Responsibilities**

- i. Execute scholarship program adhering to the THF Scholarship Guidelines and ensure efficient and smooth implementation of the scholarship programs.
- ii. Make update information available to the THFW with regard to the details pertaining to colleges/universities admissions and maintain close coordination with the resident career counselor.
- iii. Maintain data and records of the THFW with regard to their location, college/university, courses/programs of study, commencement and completion of course, payment of scholarship money and other relevant information.
- iv. Make visitations to meet the THFW to monitor and make appraisals of their progress, grievances, attendance and to obtain their feedback from the concerned college principals / lecturers / authorities and report to the Chairman, SPC.
- v. Establish and maintain contact with educational institutions/colleges/universities.
- vi. Make suggestions to the SPC in order to make the scholarship program efficient and cost effective.
- vii. Frame the annual budget for the scholarship program to be incorporated in the annual budget of THF.
- viii. Maintain update financial record of disbursement/remittance of scholarship money.

### **3. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

THF scholarship program covers all the course of study like Undergraduate / Post graduate courses in all the disciplines / M.Phil. / Ph.D / Medicine / Engineering / Professional Courses / Diploma / Vocational skill training courses, etc. in India only.

The scholarship program, however, does not cover capitation fees/donations payable to the education institutions.

THF SPC reserves prerogative to reject any application for grant of scholarship without assigning any reason.

**(A) COURSE OPTIONS:**

- i. A THFW after completing AISSCE (XII) shall have the option of pursuing any course of study based on ones AISSCE (XII) results as specified in TABLE–I on Pages 13 and 14.
- ii. Any THFW who is not able to cope with the academics of the school shall be counseled to take skill course at THF Vocational Training Centre.

**(B) UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM**

- i. THFW intent to pursue an Undergraduate Degree Courses in any discipline after successfully completing AISSCE(XII) are required to apply for scholarship in the prescribed THFW Scholarship Application Form (form B) attached at the tail of this booklet. The scholarship secretary shall verify and endorse the application for final approval of the Chairman, SPC.
- ii. THFW after completing AISSCE(XII) can also access scholarship for undergraduate courses in any Tibetan institution recognized by DOE, CTA, The Medical & Astrology courses at Tibetan Medical & Astrology College, Dharamsala and Chakpori Tibetan Medical College, Darjeeling etc.
- i. THFW after completing AISSCE (XII) can access scholarship for Diploma courses such as (a) Diploma in Nursing & Midwifery, (b) Teachers Training Course (c) Hotel Management, etc. However they are not eligible for any further scholarships after completing any of the above courses.
- iv. THFW after completing AISSCE (XII) in Arts and Commerce streams can opt B.Sc. IT/B.Sc. Food Craft & other similar science courses in the Undergraduate Degree Program. However, the percentage criteria for awarding and continuation of scholarships shall be same as that of the Commerce and Arts Stream.

**(C) ELIGIBILITY(Undergraduate Scholarship)**

- i. THFW shall have to secure minimum of 75% aggregate for Arts and Commerce stream and 70% aggregate for Science stream with five subjects (two languages and three elective subjects) and 70% aggregate for Arts and Commerce and 65% aggregate for

Science with six subjects (two languages and four elective subjects) in AISSCE (XII) to be eligible for scholarship (see Table - I on Page 13)

- ii. The bonus point for excellence (BPE) and Minus Points for Negative Records (MPNR) awarded to the THFW as per rule shall be considered only for the eligibility for awarding scholarship. However, the scholarship money shall be released as per AISSCE(XII) result.
- iii. THFW placed in the Compartment in the AISSCE(XII) are not eligible for scholarship. However, those with Mathematics as one of the subjects in class XII and has passed in said subject in AISSCE(XII) but placed in compartment are eligible for undergraduate course scholarship provided he/she passes the failed subject in the first compartmental examination conducted by CBSE.

**(D) CONTINUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP (Undergraduate)**

- i. For continuation of scholarship for pursuing B.A. and B. Com. Pass courses shall have to secure minimum of 55% aggregate marks or 5.5 CGPA in the last examination.
- ii. For continuation of scholarship for pursuing B.Sc., and B.A./B.Com. Courses with honours/major in one of the subjects, and other professional degrees in Medical Courses, Engineering/Technological and Business studies, etc., shall have to secure minimum of 50% aggregate or 5.0 CGPA in the last examination.

**(E) POSTGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM**

- i. THFW may apply for Post Graduate Degree Program by submitting the Course Completion Report (form C) attached at the tail of this booklet. The scholarship secretary shall verify and endorse the application for final approval of the Chairman of Scholarship Committee.

**(F) ELIGIBILITY (Postgraduate Scholarship)**

- i. A THFW should have completed the undergraduate study program within the prescribed period of time.
- ii. A THFW should have secured in the undergraduate exams a minimum 60% aggregate in Pass Course, 55% aggregate in Honours/Major & Science Course or 60% in professional degree in Medical Courses, Engineering/Technological and Business Studies, etc. (Table-I on page 14)

**(G) CONTINUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP (Postgraduate)**

- i. For continuation of scholarship the THFW should have secured at least 50% aggregate marks or 5.0 CGPA in the last exam.

**(H) DIPLOMA COURSES.**

- i. THFW intent to pursue Diploma Course for one or two years after successfully completing AISSCE(XII) are required to apply for scholarship in the prescribed **THFW Scholarship Application Form (form B)** attached at the tail of this booklet. The scholarship secretary shall verify and endorse the application for final approval of the Chairman of Scholarship Committee.

**(I) ELIGIBILITY (Diploma Courses)**

- i. THFW shall have to secure minimum of 55% aggregate in AISSCE(XII) to avail scholarship for two years diploma course. (see Table - I on page 14)
- ii. THFW who have passed but secured less than 55% is eligible for scholarship for one year diploma course. (see Table - I on page 14).
- iii. THFW placed in the Compartment in the AISSCE(XII) but have cleared the failed subject in the first attempt within the prescribed period of time are also eligible for scholarships for diploma courses.
- iv. The bonus point for excellence (BPE) and Minus Points for Negative Records (MPNR) awarded to the THFW as per rule shall be considered only for the eligibility for awarding scholarship. However, the scholarship money shall be released as per AISSCE(XII) result.

**(J) PROFESSIONAL DEGREE PROGRAM**

- i. THFW are eligible for scholarship for pursuing professional courses like B.Ed., M.Ed., L.L.B., B.Lib./M.Lib., B.A./B.Sc. B.Ed., B.Sc. Nursing., B.A. LLB., etc. after the completion of qualifying examination.
- ii. The eligibility criteria and scholarship procedure are the same as that of Undergraduate Degree and post graduate degree program.

**(K) M. Phil. and Ph. D. Program.**

THFW inclined to pursue M. Phil or Ph. D. after successfully completing Post Graduate Degree can apply for scholarship by submitting the Course Completion Report (form C) attached at the tail of this booklet. The scholarship secretary shall verify the application and endorse it for final approval of the Chairman of SPC.

### **(L) Eligibility**

- i. A THFW is eligible for scholarships for M. Phil. and Ph. D. after successfully completing postgraduate master's degree. Scholarship shall be released only after the submission of the admission confirmation in a recognized University/Institution.
- ii. M. Phil and Ph. D scholarship shall be awarded only to the scholastically deserving wards with proven academic record and subject to the availability of funds. The Chairman, SPC can approve/reject an application without assigning reasons.
- iii. The scholarship for M. Phil will be provided for one academic year only. The scholarship for Ph. D will be provided for the first three and half consecutive years.
- iv. One time extension of six months may be sanctioned on merit of the case. No further extension shall be given.
- v. THFW inclined to pursue Ph. D. program after successfully completing M. Phil. shall be considered for grant of scholarship only for two and half academic years which can be extended for not more than six months provided he/she has not availed of the extension during M. Phil program.
- vi. A copy of dissertation/thesis and synopsis of it must be presented to THF for library references.

### **(M) COURSES AT CUTS FOR HIGHER TIBETAN STUDIES.**

- i) THFW may also apply for scholarship/allowances for higher Tibetan Studies at Central Universities for Tibetan Studies (CUTS)-Sarnath after class VIII.
- ii) THF will provide allowances such as Stationery, Clothing, Pocket Money and Extra Diet allowances as per THF Scholarship Guidelines.

## **4. COMPLETION OF COURSE OF STUDY**

THFW after successfully completing any course/program shall have to fill up the Course Completion Report (form C) attached at the tail of this booklet and submit it to the Scholarship Section within fifteen days from the last date of the final examination. The attested copy of last exam mark sheet may be submitted as when it is announced and issued.

## **5. SPECIAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP**

### **Merit Awards**

- i. In order to promote excellence in education, THF Merit Awards have been constituted to be awarded on the basis of percentage

marks secured in the qualifying examination. The details of Merit Award are mentioned in Table-II on page 13 of this booklet (Disbursement of Scholarships). The value of special merit scholarship are as follows:

- a) Additional sum of Rs. 10000/- per academic year over and above the basic scholarship amount for securing 80% and above in the qualifying exam.
- b) Additional sum of Rs. 15000/- per academic year over and above the basic scholarship amount for securing 85% and above in the qualifying exam.
- c) Additional sum of Rs. 20000/- per academic year over and above the basic scholarship for securing 90% and above in the qualifying exam.
- d) Securing 95% and above in the qualifying exam is eligible for Sikyong Scholarship.

#### **6. COMPETITIVE ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS**

- i. THFW after AISSE (X) and AISSCE (XII) is eligible to participate in Competitive Entrance Examinations conducted by DOE, CTA.
- ii. Travelling expenses for test destination shall be reimbursed to three toppers of AISSE and AISSCE exams for all the three streams only for one entrance test.

#### **7. OPEN SCHOOL AND CORRESPONDENCE COURSE**

THF encourages its staff personnel and THF-VTC trainees to pursue Distance Learning/Correspondence Course in order to upgrade Educational Qualifications.

- i. Expenses for pursuing Distance Learning/Correspondence Courses for THF-VTC trainees shall be borne by THF.
- ii. Staffs members of THF can apply for scholarship for distance learning/correspondence courses. The Chairman, SPC shall determine such cases recommended by the concerned section head. The quantum of such an incentive shall not be more than Rs. 5000.00 per academic year. The reimbursement shall be made on submission of the bills of expenditure.

#### **8. MEDICAL ALLOWANCE**

THFW needing medical attention/treatment/hospitalization on account of illness or accident, during the course of study shall have to intimate THF, SS. The procedures for claiming reimbursement for medical treatment are as follows:-



- i. The THFW shall have to inform THF, SS as soon as possible when a medical treatment is needed on account of falling sick/accident.
- ii. THFW requiring prolong hospitalization/medical care can opt for such medical care at THF hospital and avail the medication benefits available to THFW including the travel expenses.
- iii. A THFW can also choose to take medical treatment at the place of location and entitled to claim the medical treatment by submitting the relevant bills of medication expenses. THF shall reimburse 50% of the medical treatment expenses provided the bills are found relevant and valid on verification by THF hospital.
- iv. Any accident case shall have to be reported to a local Government hospital as required by law and to the THF, SS. In case of hospitalization, the patient shall stay in General Ward. Expenditure incurred for special wards, deluxe/semi deluxe rooms/luxury wards shall not be borne/reimbursed by THF. Hospitalization in ICU shall be considered as an exception.
- v. Full medical expenditure of destitute category THFW shall be borne by THF.

## **9. BONUS POINT FOR EXCELLENCE (BPE) AND MINUS POINTS FOR NEGATIVE RECORD(MPNR)**

A system of awarding BPE and giving MPNR has been introduced in the THF Scholarship program with single objective to promote excellence and deter indiscipline and academic mediocrity among the children.

### **(a) Bonus Points for Excellence (BPE)**

- i. The BPE shall be evaluated on the basis of the academic performance in the internal Annual Examination conducted by the school.
- ii. The Principal shall submit the list of prospective students for awarding BPE to the SS before the declaration of the AISSCE(XII) result and shall be added to the overall marks percentage of AISSCE(XII) before awarding scholarship.
- iii. BPE shall not be considered for the merit award. Details are given in Table IV on page 15

### **(b) Minus Points for Negative Records (MPNR)**

- i. The MPNR shall be evaluated and given by THF Discipline Committee on the basis of records of breach of rules and indiscipline during the past one year.

- ii. THF Discipline Committee shall submit the MPNR to the SS before the declaration of AISSCE (XII) results and shall be deducted from overall marks percentage of AISSCE(XII) before awarding scholarship.
- iii. The quantum of MPNR shall be -0.5 to -2.5.

## **10. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- i. THF Scholarship Program does not cover children under THF outreach program and THFW who contributes maintenance and utility charges with an exception to the school topper.
- ii. THF staff children studying in non-Tibetan Schools may also apply for THF scholarships provided they have passed class X from a recognized school with Tibetan as one of the languages or have passed the Tibetan Language Test conducted by DOE-CTA for the award of scholarships.
- iii. THFW who have received scholarship for Undergraduate Program can join M.B.B.S./B.D.S/B.Pharm./B.E./B.Tech./B.A.LLB./B.Sc. Hotel Management / B.P.Ed., etc. in between the courses. Scholarship for such courses shall be released after deducting the sum of money already paid for undergraduate courses.
- iv. THFW opting for such courses after completing an academic year in a particular degree program shall have to pass the examination with the minimum percentage required for the continuation of scholarship.
- v. THFW can be allowed to take a Gap-Year on bonafide medical/unavoidable grounds upon obtaining prior written approval of the Chairman, SPC.
- vi. THFW can also be allowed to take a Gap-Year for preparing for Entrance Exams upon obtaining prior written approval of the Chairman, SPC and he/she gets admission in the course for which Entrance Exam was written.
- vii. THFW are advised to stay in communication with the THF Scholarship Section.
- viii. THFW shall not be allowed to discontinue/break a course in-between, change course of study, remain absent from exams conducted by the university except on genuine medical reasons or unavoidable circumstance for which permission of the THF SPC shall have to be obtained.
- ix. Any complaint received from college/university/institute

authority/lecturer in connection with the THFW behavior/attendance and any other illegal activities shall be considered as a serious offence. In such cases appropriate action against the concerned THFW shall be taken including termination and discontinuation of scholarship.

- x. THF shall not be responsible for loss of scholarship money or personal belongings due to the negligence on the part of THFW.
- xi. THFW shall have to clear the qualifying examination conducted by the university before applying for the continuation of scholarship. The scholarship shall be sanctioned only after producing the pass certificates of the qualifying examination with minimum required percentage.
- xii. Subsequent scholarship installments shall be released on submission all the original bills and receipts of the expenditure duly attested by the college principals/dean/department heads/General Secretary/Asst. Secretary/EO.
- xiii. For the final year of any course of study, 25% of the scholarship amount shall with held till the submission of Course Completion Report and the attested copy of the final year exam mark sheet.
- xiv. THF shall not bear the expenditure for repeating a course of study.
- xv. MBBS/Nursing/professional course students receiving monetary allowance/benefits during internship/housemanship tenure shall not be entitled to the usual THF pocket money.
- xvi. Fees for payable for revaluation, improvement, recheck, compartmental examination and examination as a private candidate shall not be borne/reimbursed by THF.
- xvii. Details of travel expenditure for THFW for journeys to different places for seeking admission in colleges/universities after passing AISSCE(XII) and finalization of respective scholarships are furnished in Table-V on page 16.
- xviii. Fees for any kind of Eligibility Certificate (EC) applicable to Indian student category shall be reimbursed by THF.
- xix. THFW must discharge/clear all the dues payable to the college/university/institution on time. Penalties and fines for delayed payment of fees shall not be borne/reimbursed by THF.
- xx. THFW shall have to pay refundable deposits of any kind. No reimbursement shall be made by THF for refundable deposits.
- xxi. THFW after completing class X can be allowed to take Physical

Education as fifth subject provided he/she assures to pursue B. P. Ed. after completing AISCCE (XII). Otherwise P. Ed. or Multi Media shall be allowed only as sixth subject.

- xxii. THFW not qualified for scholarship for undergraduate/equivalent courses and have qualified for one or two year diploma courses but opted to take undergraduate/equivalent courses shall be given a lump sum incentive of Rs. 25,000.00 (Twenty Five Thousand Only) per academic year for a maximum of three years provided he/she is enrolled for a regular course of study/training in a recognized universities/institutions and exam results are submitted to the scholarship section.
- xxiii. Destitute and genuinely needy THFW requiring money for paying college admission fees can make applications to the Chairman, SPC for advance through THF Registration and Administration Section. The Chairman, SPC can sanction such advance at the recommendation of R&A Section.
- xxiv. Orphan/destitute category THFW solely dependent on the THF can apply for special financial support to the THF.
- xxv. The existing system of institutional billings is abolished however the institutional billing in case of THFW studying at TCV Selaqui shall continue as before. The stationery and clothing allowance shall be distributed separately as per THF Scholarship Guidelines. Pocket money will be also distributed provided it is not included in the institutional billing received from the TCV Selaqui Office.

#### **11. SCHOLARSHIP VALUE AND DISBURSEMENT MODALITY**

- i. The value of the scholarship for an academic year is furnished in Table No:- II and III on page 15 of this booklet. A scholarship sum includes Tuition Fees, Maintenance overheads, Stationery, Clothing, Pocket Money and Merit Award.
- ii. The disbursement of scholarship money shall be made by the THF Scholarship Section in two installments as follows:
  - a. First Installment..... July-August
  - b. Second Installment..... December-January
- iii. Maintenance and Pocket money shall be paid for 12 months in an academic year.
- iv. Clothing and Stationery allowances shall be paid once a year.
- v. THFW pursuing professional courses whose total annual fees amounts to more than Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh), the entire

THF scholarship amount entitled for such course for a year may be released at the commencement of the academic session.

- vi. College fees shall include fees for admission /tuition /lab/ exam/ library / computer and eligibility certificate fee (Indian Category).
- vii. Special allowances of Rs. 600/- per month shall be given in addition to the scholarship amount to orphans/destitute category on the basis of the recommendation of the THF-Registration and Admission Section.
- viii. THFW studying at Sarnath shall be given Rs. 400/- month extra as Food Allowances (Diet).
- ix. Award of Scholarship for extremely destitute children failing to qualify for the scholarship as per THF scholarship guidelines shall be discussed at MC meeting and appropriate decision will be taken on the basis of the recommendation of the Registration and Administration Section.

## **12.COMPLIANCE OF THF SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

1. This Revised THF Scholarship Guidelines shall become operative w.e.f. 1st July 2019 and supersedes the one published in 2017 and subsequent amendments made till date.
2. SPC can make any amendments in the THF Scholarship Guidelines from time to time on the basis of the need of the THF and the Tibetan Society.
