

THE EDITORIAL BOARD MEMBERS



The editorial board members consist of teachers and students, and their primary responsibility is to produce the school's annual magazine. The process typically begins two to three months before the magazine is published. Teachers involved in the editorial board ask students in each class to write compositions in either Tibetan or English and inform the art teacher to collect drawings for the magazine.

Once the compositions are collected, the teachers review all the articles to determine which ones should be included. We aim to feature as many articles as possible. Afterward, the articles are handed over to the student board members for typing and initial corrections. Final editing is done by the teachers, who dedicate additional time after school hours for this task.

The edited content is then passed to the school's IT teachers for layout and final formatting. Once the layout is completed, the IT team prints a draft, which is reviewed and re-edited by the editorial teachers. The magazine is also examined by the school administrator. Once all feedback is addressed and there are no objections, the magazine is sent for final printing.
